

County Commissioners Special Meeting
January 23, 2023

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:07 a.m. Commissioners Miller and Fine were also present.

Will Fine led prayer, Doolen led Flag Salute.

Fine made a motion to approve the January 3 and January 5, 2023 Meetings. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

The Commissioners discussed application to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). Jacktown Fire wants to apply for the purchase of a Fire Pumper/Rescue Truck. Lincoln County wants to apply for a new handicap accessible parking lot. Due to survey requirements, the Commissioners chose to allow Jacktown Fire to apply for the grant since they already have their survey done. Lincoln County will work on their survey and apply for the grant in 2024. Miller made the motion and Fine seconded. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.
