

County Commissioners Meeting
October 18, 2021

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:07 a.m. Commissioners Munson and Miller were also present.

Prayer was led by Will Fine and the Flag Salute was led by Lee Doolen.

Munson made a motion to approve minutes from the October 4 and October 14, 2021 meetings. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Bid #22-02 for the purchase of a Water Tender Apparatus for Kendrick Fire Department was opened with the following bids:

Command Fire Apparatus – No Bid
Fire Tech - \$54,000

COEDD and Kendrick Fire Department took bid to review.

Munson made a motion to accept Fire Tech's Bid of \$54,000 based on Kendrick Fire Department's request. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

No action was taken on Agenda Item # 6 to review Employee Incident Reports and Accident Claims to approve or deny safety bonuses.

Miller made a motion to approve REAP Grant Application and Resolution for District #2 to lay 4" of asphalt on Sandy Lane, NS3450 between 8th and 15th Street project. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Service Dog Etiquette Class in Safety Training Schedule. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

The Commissioners discussed Redistricting for Lincoln County. Doolen said that the simplest way to redistrict is to add 30 miles to the South border of District #1. This will even out the population and will not disrupt the whole county. Munson expressed his concern for funding if miles were added to his district and wants to ensure that funding would be reapportioned if that happens. Miller said that the best thing for the whole county is to give a little bit of every kind of road for each district by rolling the districts clockwise. It would even out the road miles and would distribute more money per mile. Doolen made a motion to add thirty miles to the South border of District #1. There was no second to this motion. Miller made a motion to approve the map and Resolution #21-83 that moves District #1 south into Prague, moves District #3 up the West side of the county to the North border and moves District #2 eastwardly. Motion seconded by Munson. Miller and Munson voted aye. Doolen voted nay.

No action taken on Agenda Item #9 to discussion and possibly take action concerning reallocation of county funds in light of redistricting.

No action was taken on Agenda Item #10 concerning Tryon yard. Suggestion was made by D.A. to get with Alicia @ County Clerk's office to pull title records as to lease and/or ownership.


