Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 1:02 p.m. Marlon Miller and Will Fine were also present.

Ross Naylor from OPEH&W was also present to answer questions in regards to the County Health Insurance plan.

OPEH&W is a public trust. The Board is made up of members from public entities that participate in the plan.

Lee Doolen asked if employees could choose a lower plan than the Diamond Preferred and then be paid the difference. Mr. Naylor does not believe that the employee can be paid the difference, but it is possible for them to choose a lower plan. The difference may be able to be made up by applying it to other benefits.

More research will be done to determine what is legal according to State Statutes. Whatever decision is made, Ross said that he would present the options when he does a benefit presentation for Lincoln County employees on January 8, 2024.

Fine made a motion to approve claims. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to adjourn. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine voted aye.
