

County Commissioners Meeting
February 16, 2021

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:03 A.M. Commissioners Munson and Miller were also present.

Flag Salute was led by Lee Doolen and prayer was led by Alicia Wagnon.

Munson made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 1, 4 and 11, 2021 Commissioner meetings. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to send a letter to the Oklahoma Commissioner of Land Office requesting to purchase five to fifteen acres of land in Section 16-14-4 just South of the County Fair grounds. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve the Linking agreement with the Bank of America for the County P-Card. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve the Lincoln County P-Card Use Procedures. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve the State Auditor's Policies and Procedures Manual for the P-Card. Doolen suggested attaching card user agreements to the manual for authorized users of the P-Card. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Resolution #21-11 accepting a donation in District #2 for the purchase of two tin horns from NAIFCO. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Doolen made a motion to declare February 1, 2021 as Randy Adams Day, honoring Mr. Adams in his retirement from Lincoln County and thanking him for his service. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

She reported that Storm #2 will begin around 3:00 – 4:00 today and last into tomorrow with another 4 – 8 inches of snow impacting the area. Governor Stitt requested a State of Emergency so Wendi asked the Commissioners to keep track of equipment and labor used for the removal of snow.
